

Pedro Tatanka

Singer, ESC 2021, Portugal

BIOGRAPHY

Born in Sintra, Tatanka became famous as the lead singer of the band *The Black Mamba*. In 2016 he started his solo career, in a more personal mood and looking at his roots, and always telling stories and presenting original songs in Portuguese. "Alfaiate" and "De Alma Despida" are his first songs presented in May 2017. In the same year, Tatanka assumed the role as musical mentor of the project "7 Maravilhas de Portugal – Aldeias", at the invitation of the producer Tavolanostra. During the shows Tatanka starred, along with other musicians, unique and intimate acoustic moments, in the context of each host village. Raquel Tavares, Áurea, Os Azeitonas, António Zambujo, Mariza Liz, The Black Mamba, Ana Bacalhau, Lúcia Moniz and Luísa Sobral were the other invited musicians. In December 2017, he debuted his solo project in Casa da Música (Sala 2), with a sold out show along with several other invited musicians. In 2018 he returned to the same concert hall, but to the main room. Tatanka's debut solo album - "Pouco Barulho" – was edited in June 2019. In the third single, "Império dos Porcos", Miguel Araújo also participated.
